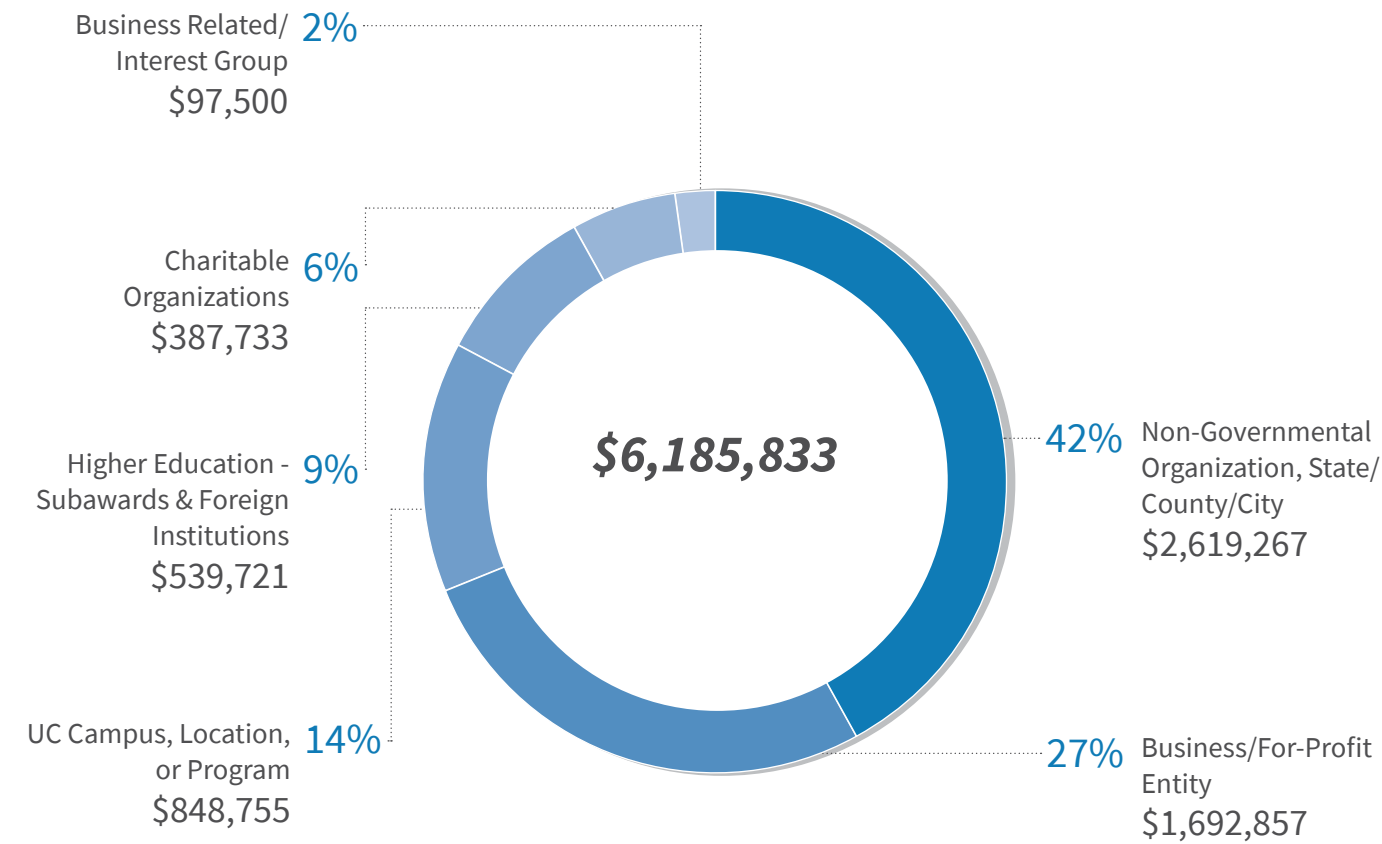
RESEARCH

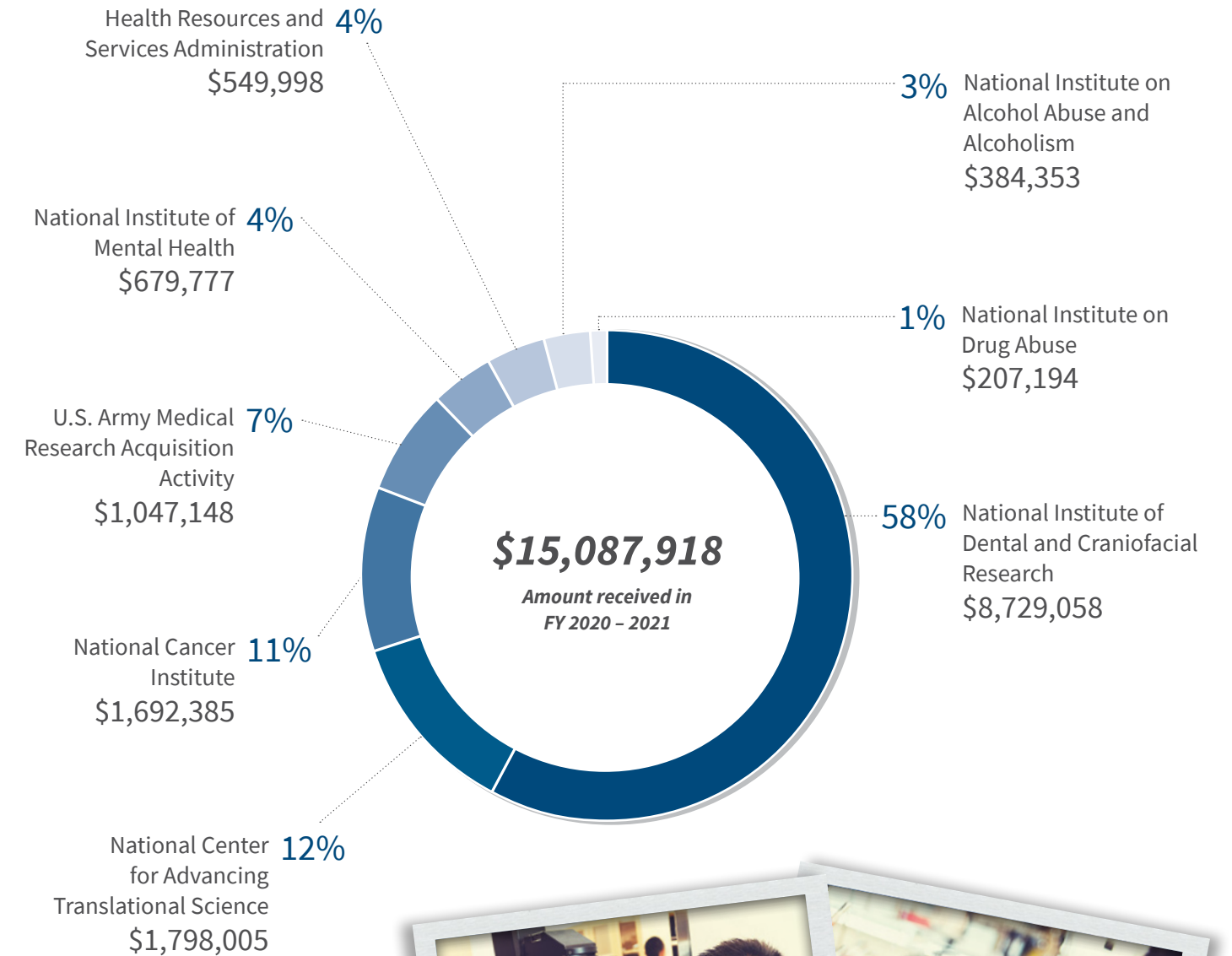
We are ranked #6 for National Institute of Dental and Craniofacial Research Grants to U.S. Academic Institutions.

RESEARCH HIGHLIGHTS

[Spectrum Solutions Collaborates with UCLA on Saliva-Based Research for the Early Detection of Lung Cancer](#)

Spectrum Solutions, LLC sponsored a research collaboration with the UCLA School of Dentistry for a study on using saliva in early lung cancer detection and analysis. Spectrum has funded a study that aims to recruit 50 patients with lung cancer and seeks to validate saliva's tumor-specific ctDNA detection sensitivity and positive agreement against tissue biopsy-based genotyping. Saliva will be collected, preserved, and transported for DNA testing using Spectrum's Saliva Collection System. The company will further support the development of clinical methods and additional technical innovations.

The study is being led by professor of oral biology, **Dr. David Wong**, from the UCLA School of Dentistry, the lead U.S. research site for the study.

The research study will compare saliva and plasma samples from NSCLC patients to identify usctDNA molecules in saliva and use special extraction methods to improve overall sensitivity of current liquid biopsy procedures.

[Unlocking the Mystery Behind Skeletal Aging](#)

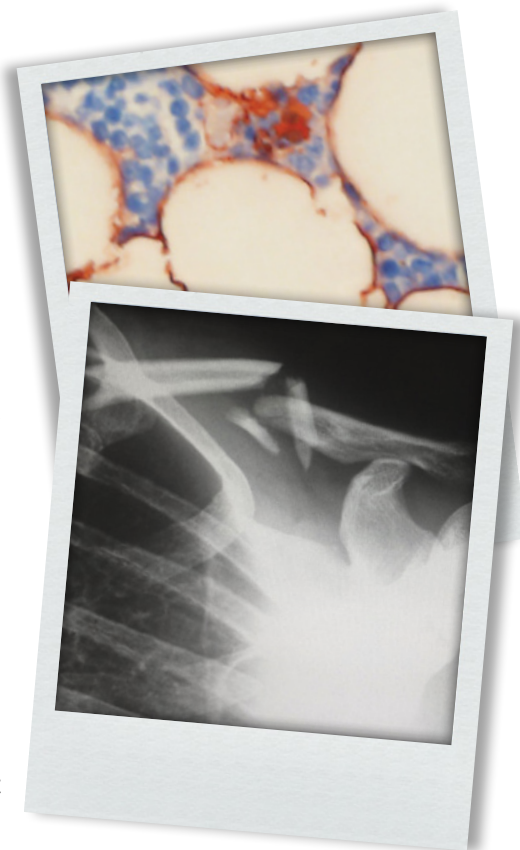

Researchers from the UCLA School of Dentistry have identified the role a critical enzyme plays in skeletal aging and bone loss, putting them one step closer to understanding the complex biological mechanisms that lead to osteoporosis, the bone disease that afflicts some 200 million people worldwide.

The findings from their study in mice, published online in the journal *Cell Stem Cell*, could hold an important key to developing more effective treatments for osteoporosis and improving the lives of an aging population, they say.

The UCLA researchers, led by distinguished professor **Dr. Cun-Yu Wang**, chair of oral biology at the dentistry school, demonstrated that when the epigenetic factor KDM4B is absent from mesenchymal stem cells, these cells are far more likely to differentiate into fat cells than bone cells, resulting in an unhealthy imbalance that exacerbates skeletal aging and leads to brittle bones and fractures over time. The work was supported by grants from the National Institute of Dental and Craniofacial Research, the UCLA Clinical and Translational Science Institute, and the generous support of the Hsieh Family Foundation.

[Deactivating Cancer Cell Gene Boosts Immunotherapy for Head and Neck Cancers](#)

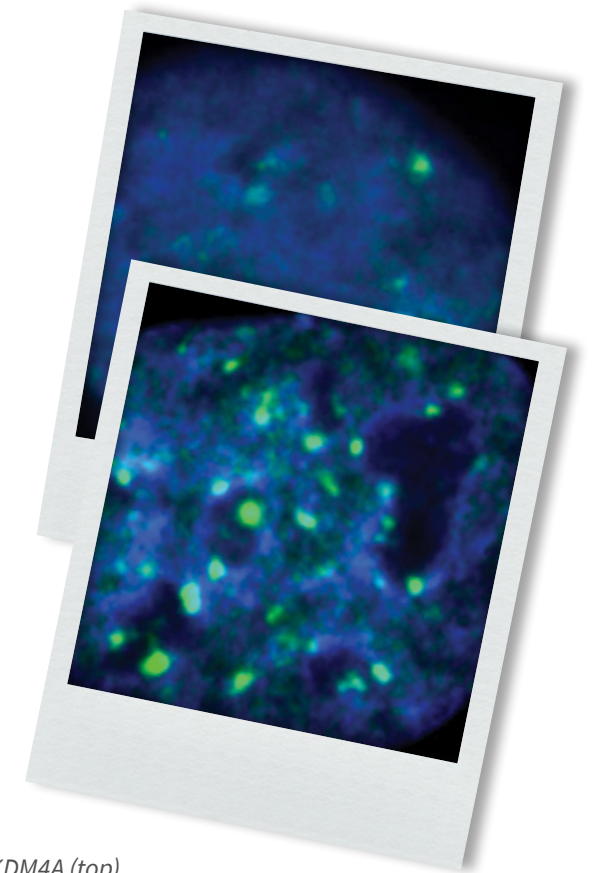

By targeting an enzyme that plays a key role in head and neck cancer cells, researchers from the UCLA School of Dentistry were able to significantly slow the growth and spread of tumors in mice and enhance the effectiveness of an immunotherapy to which these types of cancers often become resistant.

Their findings, published online in the journal *Molecular Cell*, could help researchers develop more refined approaches to combatting highly invasive head and neck squamous cell cancers, which primarily affect the mouth, nose and throat.

Immunotherapy, which is used as a clinical treatment for various cancers, harnesses the body's natural defenses to combat disease. Yet some cancers, including head and neck squamous cell carcinomas, don't respond as well to the therapy as others do. The prognosis for these head and neck cancers is poor, with a high five-year mortality rate, and there is an urgent need for effective treatments.

[UCLA Team Discovers How to Restrict Growth, Spread of Head and Neck Cancers](#)

Researchers from the UCLA School of Dentistry have discovered a key molecule that allows cancer stem cells to bypass the body's natural immune defenses, spurring the growth and spread of head and neck squamous cell cancers. Their study also demonstrates that inhibiting this molecule derails cancer progression and helps eliminate these stem cells.

Published in the journal *Cell Stem Cell*, the findings could help pave the way for more effective targeted treatments for this highly invasive type of cancer, which is characterized by frequent resistance to therapies, rapid metastasis and a high mortality rate.

Cancer stem cells, also known as tumor-initiating cells, are considered to be the original source of cancerous tissues — the cells that give rise to all other cancer cells. Their ability to survive and proliferate in the early stages of cancer development, as well as during tumor growth and metastasis, suggests they have an intrinsic ability to evade detection by the body's immune surveillance system. The researchers set out to better understand how and why this happens.

A Collective Effort

“After more than three months of only providing emergency dental services because of the pandemic, the UCLA Dental Clinics resumed ambulatory dental care in July 2020. Under strict protocols implemented for the safety of our patients and providers, patient care was successfully resumed and we were mostly back to pre-pandemic patient visit levels by the spring of 2021. The UCLA Dental Clinics did not experience a single cluster of COVID-19 spread since the resumption of regular dental care services. This shows that a collective effort in observing the infection control protocols is effective in preventing disease transmission when providing dental care.”

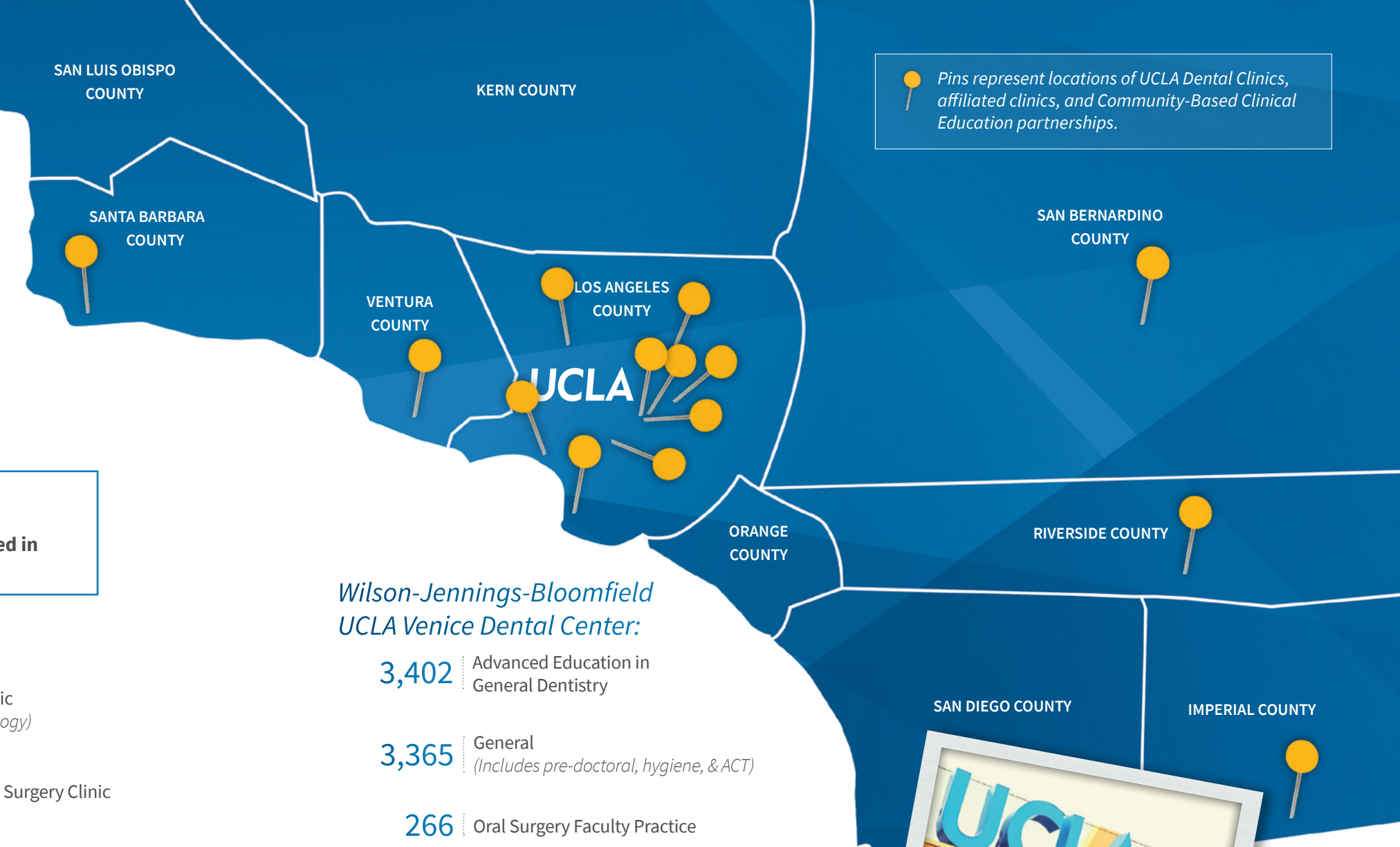

COMMUNITY-BASED CLINICAL EDUCATION (CBCE)

From July 6, 2020 to May 7, 2021, D4 students in the Class of 2021 delivered care to **4,395** unique patients and completed **11,421** procedures at eleven active CBCE sites.

With a generous \$1.5 million donation from the Delta Dental Community Care Foundation, the dental school launched its CBCE program in March 2018. Since its inception through May 7, 2021, our students, pediatric dentistry residents, and endodontic residents have delivered care for **16,617** unique patients in underserved communities.

Although the COVID-19 pandemic slowed a lot of services down, we are happy to report our program continued to find opportunities to grow during a difficult time. UCLA Dentistry's CBCE program continues to align with the School's strategic imperatives through our program's mission to enhance education while increasing access to care for underserved populations through sustainable community service.

Endodontic services by dental students have been severely affected by the COVID-19 pandemic, yet this class has performed on par with pre-covid classes and even improved the number of endodontic procedures delivered compared to last year. A CBCE rotation with 2nd year endodontic residents began at South Central Family Health Center on January 12, 2021 under the leadership of Dr. Chugal, Dr. Kang, and Dr. Chun, increasing access to a much-needed service. A major statistic to celebrate:

41% of the endodontic services delivered by predoctoral students were completed through the CBCE program at South Central Family Health Center.

This year we have found creative ways to collaborate with CBCE sites to provide services through oral health fairs in collaboration with UCLA HSDA, SCAAPD, and DEO student groups. Drive-thru oral health fairs were held to address oral health needs and provide preventive services in different parts of Los Angeles County while maintaining social distancing guidelines. CBCE piloted an expansion to include rotations with D3 PPID students with an ultimate goal to expand CBCE rotation opportunities for all D3 dental students. UCLA School of Dentistry is grateful to board members Dr. Mitra Mogharabi Ardehali and Dr. Kami Hoss for their generous support of this program.

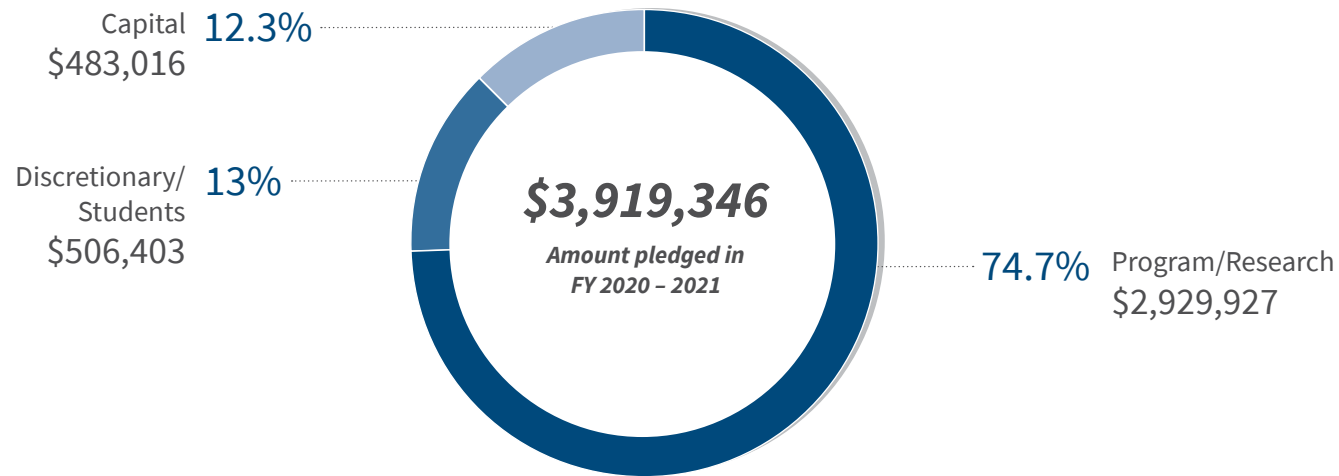

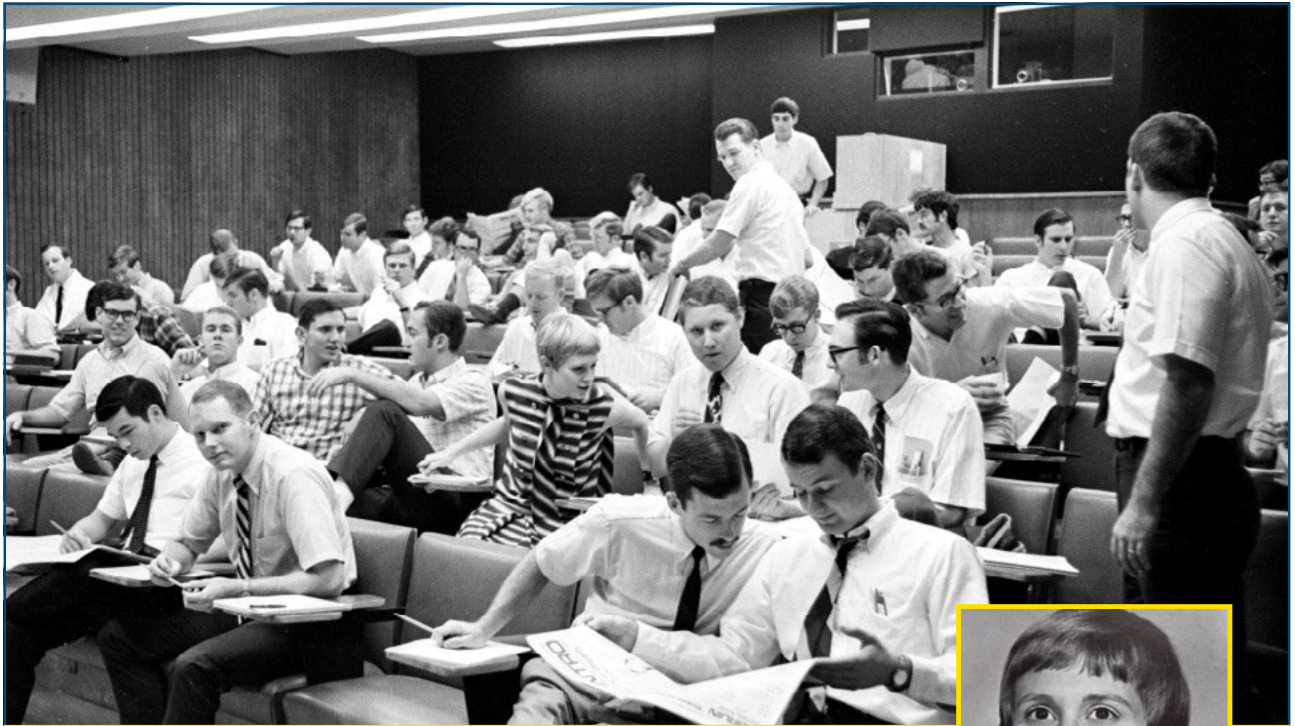
