

EAPs are governed by UCLA Campus Policy 811, Cal/Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA Title 8 Subchapter 7 Group 1 Article 2 §3220 Emergency Action Plan and OSHA 29 Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) 1910.38, Emergency Action Plans.

Per these policies, an EAP must be:

- In writing
- Kept in the workplace
- Available to employees for review

Evacuation Routes Location of the nearest emergency stair exit to exterior of building and include alternate route if identified.	1st Floor: Please use the main entrance or the emergency exits to leave the building. The emergency gathering point is the west of the parking lot.	
	2nd Floor: Please use either the 200 or the 201 stairs to exit to the 1st floor, and then use the main entrance or the emergency exits to leave the building and gather at the west end of the parking lot.

Staff Skillsets and Training

This roster lists department staff in the building with specialized skillsets and training that may be able to provide support during an evacuation. This includes **Rescue and Medical Training** that has certified staff to provide medical support during evacuation such as First Aid and CPR.

All staff are designated as **Bruin Emergency Staff (BES)** and are responsible for supporting emergency preparedness activities before, during and after an emergency.

Department Safety Liaisons should coordinate with staff requiring special assistance in an evacuation to identify support needs and mobility assistants who can help them during an emergency evacuation.


Staff members requiring assistance are encouraged to self-identify in advance in order to better plan for their safety in an emergency.
